Please Note: All Kindergarten students will attend classes on September 4, 5, and 6 from 8:30 a.m. until 11:45 a.m. Starting Monday, September 9th all Kindergarten students will be attending school on a full time basis from 8:30 -2:30 p.m. We believe that this minor change will make the first few school days more enjoyable and comfortable for your children, and the adjustment to school easier. Please send a snack with your child.

There will be no registration of children the first day of school. The office will open on August 26 and will accept payment between the hours of 10:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Tuition payment must be made by August 30, 2024 unless you are on the FACTS Program. **Also tuition payment can be mailed.** No tuition payment will be accepted on the first day of school.

NOTE: All students must be dressed in complete school uniform on the first day of school. For the month of September and October students will be dressed in summer school uniform.
